

The committees through which the parish council is organised

There are three main committees which deal with parish council business. They are the full Council, which all parish councillors are expected to attend, a Finance and General Purposes (FGP) Committee which is made up of a number of parish councillors, and the Recreation and Environment Committee, also made up by a number of parish councillors. The Full Council is chaired by the Parish Chairman, Brian Morsley, the FGP by David Stabler, while Charles Allum chairs the Recreation Committee.

Committees are held on a regular cycle, with Full Council meetings being held on the third Tuesday of each month, while FGP meets on the first Wednesdays each month. Recreation Committee meets on the second Tuesday of each month. **THERE ARE NO MEETINGS IN AUGUST.**
