COUNCILLORS ITEMS:

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT & SOCIAL ENTERPRISE:

DISABLED PARKING: Cllr Mallyon advised that he receives many complaints regarding the abuse of the disabled parking bays at Neath Hill. The Parish Council also receive a lot of complaints about Neath Hill and Giffard Park. Cllr Mallyon was directed to Cllr Williams (Milton Keynes Council), who is currently looking into this matter.
