**Tongwell Lake:** The gate has now been installed at the bottom of Tongwell Lane, which will stop unauthorised access.

**Church Lees-Great Linford:** Fly tipping is a problem, this will be reported.

**Lorry Management Strategy/Routes:** It is the intention to create more parking for lorries, but EP are not helpful in providing land for this purpose.
