- a) **Downs Barn School:** Following discussion it was proposed by Cllr Pugh and seconded by Cllr Allum, that this application be refused, but that the school be given the contact details of Pete Cox (Leisure Services), who currently has funding to promote tennis. All agreed.
- b) **Giffard Park Pre-School:** Following discussion it was proposed by Cllr Morsley and seconded by Cllr Pugh, that two screens (approx price £239), be purchased. All Agreed.
- c) **Great Linford Football Club:** After discussion it was proposed by Cllr Allum and seconded by Cllr Tripp, that a grant of £80 be made towards the purchase of a new equipment storage shed. All agreed.

Stantonbury Park Farm: There is an open meeting with developers at Stantonbury on 7th June and Haversham on 8th June.

Gyosei School Development: Details have been obtained under the Freedom of Information Act. It appears that a Development Brief for the playing field site has already been drawn up, although the Parish Council have not been consulted. Parish Manager has been asked to write to Sir Bob Red (MK Partnership Committee), and requesting discussions before the matter proceeds any further.
