

# GREAT LINFORD PARISH COUNCIL

## Minutes of the Meeting of the FGP Committee, held on Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2006 at the Parish Office.

**1. APOLOGIES:** Cllr Figg, Cllr Macaulay.

**2. DECLARATIONS OF MEMBERS INTERESTS:** There were no declarations of interest.

**3. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:** It was proposed by Cllr Markley and seconded by Cllr Tripp that the minutes of the meeting held on 4th October 2006 be accepted as a true record.

**4. MATTERS ARISING:**

**HIMOs:** Request that Milton Keynes Council be asked whether there is a fire check on all premises that have planning permission, to confirm that fire regulations are being conformed too.

**06/01504 Canal Villa, Great Linford:** Application to cut back trees has been withdrawn.

**06/01288 28 High Street, Great Linford:** Application to change rear windows – this application has been refused.

**06/01184 The Old Wharf House Great Linford:** Application for new gates, this application has been refused.

**5. PLANNING APPLICATIONS:**

06/01559            4 The Crescent, Great Linford            No objections

06/01666            24 Lanfranc Gardens, Bolbeck Park        Application to convert one semi-detached bungalow, into two properties. To make the point about parking standards, also does the property meet the fire regulations.

06/01684            11 Broadpiece, Pennyland                    Comments about what appears to be inadequate parking on the plot, does it meet Milton Keynes Standards.

**6. PARISH BOUNDARY REVIEW:** Cllr Morsley and Cllr Stabler had attended a meeting at Campbell Park Parish Council and had advised them of the observations made by this Council. Letter from Woughton Parish Council asking us to enter into a Protocol regarding consultation on the Boundary Review. It was agreed that although the contents were noted, this Parish Council does not feel it necessary at this stage as we do not intend to canvass any residents.

**7. PARISH COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE:**

**Newsletter:** Delivery is virtually completed and generally has been more effective than the previous deliveries, although there are some areas where they have not been received. The key copy date for the next issue is 1<sup>st</sup> February 2007.

**Parish Information Leaflets:** A leaflet has been produced which will be copied in house, with Councillors being given some each and the rest available at reception.

**Logo:** The leaf design was generally thought to be too similar to other councils logos, after discussion the following suggestions were made, a competition for schoolchildren to design a logo (could have problems trying to reduce to the required size), local art college or competition in next News and Views. This matter will be discussed again at later stage.

**E-mail Address for Councillors:** Suggestion that Councillors have a Parish Council e-mail addresses. Discussion as to how much direct involvement Councillors should have with Milton Keynes Offices or should the majority go through the parish office, with Councillor kept informed. No decision made.

**8. COUNCILLORS ITEMS:** There were no items for discussion.

**9. DATE OF FUTURE MEETINGS:**

The next Meeting will be held on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2006. It was agreed that the January meeting would be held on the same night as the Recreation Meeting (9<sup>th</sup> January). The meeting will start at 7pm and the Parish Precept for 2007/8 will be the main topic.
