Minutes of the Meeting of the FGP Committee, held on Wednesday 7th February 2007 at the Parish Office.

1. APOLOGIES: Cllr Wright.

2. DECLARATIONS OF MEMBERS INTERESTS: There were no declarations of interest.

3. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING: It was proposed by Cllr Markley and seconded by Cllr Tripp that the minutes of the meeting held on 9th January 2007 be accepted as a true record.

4. PLANNING APPLICATIONS:

07/00044 Rear of 222/4/6 Wolverton Road, Blakelands- Objections for the following reasons:

- a) That there is only provision for 15 parking spaces. Regulations require 17.5, plus visitor parking.
- b) It is an over development of the plot
- c) The terrace stands forward from the building line of the adjacent house.

07/00045 Rear of 222/4/6 Wolverton Road, Blakelands - Concern as to whether these plans meet the PPG24 regulations relating to noise issues.

07/00114 Nags Head, 30 High Street, Great Linford No objections

06/01871 86 Cantle Avenue, Downs Barn There are concerns about the proposed parking space in front of the existing lounge. Are the Highways Dept happy with it being so close to the corner.

07/00088 30 Boulters Lock, Giffard Park No objections

HIMOs: Councillors thanked Parish Manager for her work in compiling a list of possible illegal HIMOs in Conniburrow. It is hoped that Milton Keynes Council will now take action to investigate these addresses.

5. ROCLA DEVELOPMENT-PHASE 5: There are several issues regarding these plans. It was agreed that Cllr Stabler would draft comments for English Partnerships.

6. REDWAY AT GYOSEI SITE: The trees have been removed for a redway from the site to Willen Local Centre. The Parks Trust have a substantial budget to replace the landscape. Completion is expected by the end of March. There are concerns about the gradient over the bridge in relation to electric mobility vehicles. Milton Keynes Council will be contacted.

7. BUSINESS CARDS: It was agreed that software be purchase at a cost of £19.57, which will allow cards to be printed in house.

8. COMMUNICATIONS UPDATE: The draft of the Newsletter is now complete. This will be delivered by the Community Service Teams on Sunday 4th March.
