

# Great Linford Parish Council

## *Great Locality - Proud Community*

**Minutes of the Meeting of the FGP Committee, held on Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2007 at the Parish Office.**

**PRESENT:** Cllr Stabler, (Chair), Cllr Allum, Cllr Markley, Cllr Pickhaver, Cllr Macaulay, Cllr Tripp, Cllr Figg.

**1. APOLOGIES:** Cllr Byfield, Cllr Wright, Cllr Morsley.

Cllr Stabler thanked Cllr Figg, Cllr Hobson and Cllr Wright for their period of service to this Committee.

**DECLARATIONS OF MEMBERS INTERESTS:** There were no declarations of interest.

**MINUTES OF LAST MEETING:** It was proposed by Cllr Allum and seconded by Cllr Tripp that the minutes of the meeting held on 4th April 2007 be accepted as a true record.

**MATTERS ARISING:**

**Gyosei Site:** There has been nothing further heard about the emergency access. Cllr Stabler had attended a meeting about the future of the sports field site, following the refusal of the plans by the Development Control Committee. There will now be discussion with Barratts, in order that a compromise can be found, rather than an appeal. The possibility of dualling this stretch of the V10 will be put to English Partnerships.

**PLANNING APPLICATIONS:**

**Telecommunications Installation-Neath Hill Clock Tower:** It was agreed that T Mobile should be contacted again and asked whether the equipment box could somehow be housed inside the tower, rather than outside.

**HIMOs;** The 23 applications for Conniburrow have now been re-submitted, with the letting rooms in the parking space converted to garages. It was agreed that the Parish Council Policy should be sent, and to request that the spaces are car ports rather than garages, also particular attention to the concentration of HIMOs proposed in some areas.

**SURVEY ON PCSOs:** There had been 16 replies to the survey, 11 (69%) of which were in favour of paying for additional PCSOs and 5 (31%), not in favour. As the first two PCSOs are due in the South Linford area within the next couple of weeks and two expected very soon in the North, it was agreed that the following recommendation be made to Full Council.

To inform Inspector Robinson of the consultation results and ask for the earliest deployment of the four PCSOs in the two Great Linford neighbourhood policing areas

Wait until the next financial year and if additional PCSOs are believed to be necessary, make provision for the additional cost in the 2008/9 budget and precept.

**GRANT APPLICATION-WATERSIDE FESTIVAL:** It was proposed by Cllr Figg and seconded by Cllr Macaulay, that a recommendation be made to Full Council to make a grant of £373.89 to the Waterside Festival to purchase a gazebo, trolley and side show games for the event.

**COMMUNICATIONS GROUP:** It is the intention to change the pictures on the banner of the website, there are no objections to this. A form has been compiled for Councillors to fill in their personal details, which will be condensed for the Newsletter, it was also agreed that some professional photos of Councillors be taken. Cllr Figg has a contact who may do this for the cost of materials.

**ANY OTHER BUSINESS:**

Recreation Meeting: Due to the lack of Councillors and business to discuss, it was agreed that the Recreation Meeting will not be held in MAY.
