Minutes of the Meeting of the FGP Committee, held on Wednesday 2nd April 2008 at the Parish Office.

 - 3. MINUTES OF LAST MEETING: It was proposed by Cllr Markley and seconded by Cllr Tripp that the minutes of the meeting held on 5th March 2008 be signed as a true record.**

 - 6. RENEWAL OF CONTRACTS FOR GROUND MAINTENANCE, CARETAKING AND ALLOTMENTS:**
Councillors had been circulated with current and proposed financial details.
Caretaking/Allotments/Pond Contracts: **It was proposed by Cllr Byfield and seconded by Cllr Tripp that RJS carry out all contracts for a further period of 3 yrs from 1st April 2008-Prices : Caretaking £7,739.55 per annum, Allotments/Pond £2,045.14 per season (April to October)- 5% increase on previous contract.**
Sportsground Contract: **It was proposed by Cllr Morsley and seconded by Cllr Markley that the contract be renewed for a further 3 years from 1st October 2008 and be continued by Sportground Services at an approx 5% increase –Marsh Drive £19,782 net per annum and High Street Grounds £8,568 per annum.**
The above proposals were put to a vote and it was unanimously agreed that these be the recommendations to Full Council.
