

Where's your dog bin?

MANY dog owners scoop and poop routinely after their dogs. Great Linford Parish Council provides free biodegradable poo bags. However, carrying it around or taking it home, to put in the black rubbish bags, is not the nicest of things to have to do.

This is why GLPC provide a limited number of dog bins [17] in several locations. Many owners actually plan their dog walking routine where they know where the bins are situated. For those who wish to know where the bins are, here is a guide to the area and location:

Tongwell Lake Blakelands.

- On the path to the north side Tongwell lake from Wedgwood Avenue. [25lt]
- On the path to south side of Tongwell lake just after Telford Way. [50lt]
- On path from Delaware Drive leading to Newport Pagnell. [25lt]

Downs Barn.

- At the entrance to sports facility and pavilion, Pannier Place. [25lt]
- On the footpath from Loriner Place to Windrush Close in **Downhead Park**. [25lt]

Downhead Park.

- On the footpath from Colesbourne Drive opposite the play area. [25lt]

Great Linford.

- High Street entrance to the Cricket Ground. [25lt]
- Solar Court at entrance to Cricket Ground (off Woad Lane). [25lt]
- Right-hand side of the bollards at entrance to car park off Marsh Drive. [25lt]
- Willen Lane before canal bridge 79 (off Marsh Drive). [50lt]
- Between Hartley and the school (St Ledger Drive). [25lt]
- The Green at top of High Street (Harpers Lane). [50lt]
- Middleton, adjacent grassed area along redway from St Ledger Drive to Hills Close. [25lt]

Pennyland.

- Leopard Drive by Skeats Wharf, Downhead Park end. [25lt]
- Sovereign Drive, opposite the Health Centre. [25lt]

Bolbeck Park.

- On the canal broadwalk leading to Orne Gardens near canal bridge 79c. [25lt]
- On redway off Lacy Drive opposite Flambard Close. [25lt]

Willen Park.

- Hammond Crescent adjacent the play park and canal bridge to Downhead Park. [25lt]
- On the redway along V10 Brickhill Street at the entrance to Lovat Fields. [25lt]
[All costs paid by ExtraCare]

Dog poo-bins provided and maintained by British Waterways on the canal towpath.

- South of bridge 80 H4 Danstead Way. Adjacent Hobart Crescent Willen Park. [50lt]
- Adjacent bridge 79B linking Pennyland to Bolbeck Park. [50lt]
- By bridge 78 adjacent the Giffard pub, Hainault Avenue Giffard Park. [50lt]

- Near bridge 77 on the path leading to The Wharf off Marsh Drive. [50lt]

If there are no bins around, take the scooped poop home, Milton Keynes Council Environmental Health Officers recommend that you wrap the poop bags in another plastic bag and dispose of it in your household waste black bag.

A map showing the approximate location of dog bins is available from the Parish Council Office at Heath Hill (opposite the Clock Tower). The office is open from 9am to 4pm Monday to Friday.
